Allmon Grant Fordyce, Architect, Dead

Allmon Grant Fordyce, founder and senior partner in the architectural firm of Fordyce & Hamby Associates, died yesterday of cancer at New York Hospital. He was 72 years old and lived at 870 United Nations Plaza and had a home also in Little Compton, R. I.

Among Mr. Fordyce's firm's major projects were the huge Forrestal Building in Washington and the Loula D. Lasker Memorial Swimming Pool and Skating Rink, a year-round facility in Central Park. He founded it in 1946.

Over the years, the firm designed plants and office buildings for International Business Machines Corporation, Fairchild Engine and Airplane Corporation, the State University at Plattsburgh, Lord & Taylor department stores, Singer Sewing Machine Company and Burroughs Corporation.

In 1968, Mr. Fordyce established an architectural consulting practice at 866 United Nations Plaza.
